We send out a weekly e-mail on Monday mornings that includes the GPS Guide for the week and the most recent *Minute with Matt* video.

#### GROW

Reflect on these questions as you read this scripture and hear the message for this week:

- 1) The story of David and Bathsheba illuminates the impact of sin in our lives. How would you define sin? How has your understanding and definition of sin changed through your faith journey?
- 2) How does Nathan help David acknowledge the sin in his life? Who or what leadyou to acknowledge the sin in your life?
- 3) It is only by God's grace that we are forgiven of our sin. There is nothing we can do to earn that forgiveness. In what ways have you experienced God's grace in your own life? How has your understanding of God's grace impacted your relationship with God today?

#### **PRAY**

Almighty God, we praise you for your love and forgiveness. We confess that we have not always loved you with our whole heart, and we know that we have broken your heart whenever we have turned from you and not loved our neighbor. Forgive us, and free us from the guilt we carry. We love you, Lord, and we thank you for your grace that is more than sufficient for all our needs. Lead us into a life of holiness as we seek to follow you all the days of our lives. We celebrate the gift of your Son, Jesus Christ, who died on the cross for our sins and was raised to life so that we may have eternal life with you. Praise be to God! Amen.
