A GUIDE FOR PRAYER WALKING

Monday: Focus on praying for those who are sick. Pray for healing, comfort, and peace. We also pray for the families who have lost loved ones to this illness.

Tuesday: Focus on praying for our healthcare workers in local hospitals. Pray for strength, peace, and renewed energy as they treat patients in a critical time.

Wednesday: Focus on praying for first responders and EMTs in our communities. Pray for guidance, patience, and protection as they care for those who are sick and keep us safe.

Thursday: Focus on praying for grocery store workers, truck drivers, and factory workers. Pray for continued health and strength as they provide for our well-being.

Friday: Focus on praying for teachers and educators. Pray for wisdom and guidance as they teach their students for the remainder of this year.

Saturday: Focus on praying for your neighbors. Pray for safety, health, and God's protection as we love our neighbors the way that Christ has loved us.

Sunday: Focus on praying for small businesses in our communities and local churches. Pray for guidance and comfort as many navigate difficult decisions in the midst of a changing economy. Pray for those in our churches who are struggling in faith and those who are searching for answers.
